Monday 25 th May	<p>English: Oral Language (speaking & listening skills): Look at page 108- 'The Airport in <i>Over the Moon Skills Book</i>. Talk about what you can see in the poster e.g. suitcase, passport, aeroplane etc. Language focus - I spy with my little eye something beginning with... (guess the name of the object in the poster). Now it is time to colour the picture - give your child instructions about how an item should be coloured e.g. colour the aeroplane green, colour the teddy bear brown... <i>(please refer to See-saw to listen to the vocabulary)</i>.</p> <p>Reading: Choose <u>one</u> book per day to read on www.kidsa-z.com. (please find details in your email about how you can access this website to help your child begin the reading process with books assigned to their level by class teacher).</p> <p>Wordlists: continue to practice your word lists - 10 minutes is plenty. Also encourage your child to sound-out unknown words while they are reading.</p> <p>Maths: <u>Combining</u> -pg 103 in <i>Cracking Maths workbook</i> Please see ideas on See-saw to help your child understand this Maths concept.</p> <p>Gaeilge: Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) Ceacht 6 (lesson 6) - listen to words/phrases on <i>Seesaw</i> each day along with the video or alternatively see link in box to download Interactive Irish lessons.</p> <p>Story-time: Listen to teacher read the story '<i>The Cautious Caterpillar</i>' on See-saw. Go on a mini-beast hunt in your garden and try find some of the insects mentioned in the story</p>	<p>1. <p>Tuesday 26th May</p>	<p>English: Phonics: Revise <u>all</u> letter sounds on your sound cards - look and say the sound, do the actions if you need help with a letter. Look at page 107 in <i>Over the Moon Skills</i> workbook -segmenting -spell out the words.</p> <p>Tricky Words: Revision: revise or go back over 3-4 words each day (5-10 minutes); look and say the word, practice writing the tricky word using a copy/whiteboard/chalk/magnetic letters etc. Revision page: Complete page 46 in ' <i>Over the Moon Skills book</i>' - she and I (not necessary but extra reinforcement if wanted)</p> <p>Reading: Choose one book per day to read on www.kidsa-z.com.</p> <p>Maths: Combining - pgs 104 & 105 in <i>Cracking Maths Workbook</i> Please see ideas on See-saw to help your child understand this Maths concept</p> <p>Gaeilge: Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) Ceacht 6 (lesson 6) - listen to words/phrases on <i>Seesaw</i> each day along with the video or alternatively see link in box to download Interactive Irish lessons.</p> <p><i>Other suggestions: (pick and choose what suits you)</i></p> <p>Integrated Play: Water-play - use a plastic container with water toys and junk materials e.g. tubs, yoghurt cartons, lunchboxes. Sand-play- fill a container with sand and use a variety of junk materials and small figures. 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<p>Well-Being Wednesday 27th May</p>	<p>Art- Make a paper-plate butterfly or paint one-half of a butterfly template and fold over paper to make the other half or make a handprint butterfly - follow directions on See-saw</p> <p>Relax Kids with Michelle - Please see video on See-saw which will be put up on Wednesday morning. Activities include mindfulness, breathing techniques etc. for your child to engage with.</p> <p>Physical Education (P.E): Choose an activity from the Super Trooper Journal in your child's homework folder</p>	<p>See See-saw for some ideas and inspiration. <p>Thursday 28th May</p>	<p>English: Writing -Look at <i>Mrs Murphy's handwriting copy 2</i> (green cover) and find the next two pages. Trace your finger around the letter multiple times using your 'peter-pointer' and make the letter in the air/on the table/in a sand-tray etc. Now you are ready to begin writing! Make sure your child is sitting upright and holding her pencil with the correct pencil grip. Trace the letter and the bottom row is provided for independent practice (you might need to draw the dots for your child), make sure they keep the letter on the blue lines.</p> <p><i>Mrs Murphy's pattern copy 1 & 3</i> (red/yellow covers) can be used as extra practice but is not necessary and your child can do as many or as little pages as she wishes.</p> <p>Reading: Choose one book per day to read on www.kidsa-z.com.</p> <p>Maths: Combining - pg 105 in <i>Cracking Maths Workbook</i></p> <p>Gaeilge: Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) Ceacht 6 (lesson 6) - listen to words/phrases on <i>Seesaw</i> each day along with the video or alternatively see link in box to download Interactive Irish lessons.</p>	<p>https://www.nessy.com/uk/apps/hairy-letters - helps with letter formation</p>
