Weekly Schedule	Subject/Activities	Websites
Monday 27 <sup>th</sup> April	<p><b>English:</b> Oral Language (speaking &amp; listening skills): Look at page 84- <i>The Puppet Show</i> in <i>Over the Moon Skills Book</i> and talk about the picture e.g. who do you see in the poster? What are they doing? Where are they? Why are they at the theatre? Name the things you see at the Puppet show.</p> <p>Language focus - I spy with my little eye something beginning with... (guess the name of the object in the poster).</p> <p>Now it is time to colour the picture - give your child instructions about how an item should be coloured e.g. colour the boy eating popcorn red or colour the puppets green etc.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Ordinal Numbers -pg 87 in <i>Cracking Maths workbook</i>: Line up a selection of toys -Which toy is first/last?</p> <p><b>Gaeilge:</b> Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) Ceacht 1 (lesson 1) - listen to words on <i>Seesaw</i> and sing song each day along with the video or alternatively see link in box to download Interactive Irish lessons.</p> <p><b>Art</b> (optional): using a variety of materials such as wool, googly eyes, lollipop sticks, scraps of paper and fabric - the children could make their own stick puppets for their own 'puppet show' or alternatively draw your favourite character from a Fairytale story e.g. Little Red Riding Hood, Cinderella, Snow White etc.</p>	<p>1. Tuesday 28 <sup>th</sup> April	<p><b>English:</b> Phonics: Revise the next phase of letter sounds (d, g, o, u, l, f) using sound cards in homework folder - sing songs and do actions; Letter hunt -find objects in your home that begin with the above six letters.</p> <p>Look at page 91 in <i>Over the Moon Skills Book</i> - blend/read/listen to -et words and write the word to match each picture.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Ordinal Numbers- pg 88 in <i>Cracking Maths Workbook</i></p>	<p><b>Phonics websites:</b> <a href="http://www.starfall.com">www.starfall.com</a> <a href="https://www.phonicsbloom.com/">https://www.phonicsbloom.com/</a> <a href="http://www.teachyourmonsterhowtoread.com">www.teachyourmonsterhowtoread.com</a></p>

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	<p>* <b>Cracking Maths Home Link workbook</b> can be used as extra material based on the Ordinal Numbers (pgs 28-29) but not necessary.</p> <p><b>Gaeilge:</b> Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) ceacht 1 (lesson 1) - listen to words on See-saw and sing song each day along with the video</p> <p><b>Aistear/Play:</b> Using blocks, lego etc the children could build a puppet theatre/stage for the puppets and seats for the audience.</p>	
<p><b>Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April</b></p>	<p><b>English: Tricky Words</b> -Introduce 2 new Tricky words <b>be</b> and <b>was</b> - look and say the word; put the word into a sentence; find these tricky words in your story books, practice writing/tracing the tricky words on blank pages, white/blackboards.</p> <p>Look closely at the shape of the word - how many letters does it have? Trace around the shape of the word, write it in sand/paint or make the word using play-dough. Using magnetic letters, your child can make the tricky words on mini-whiteboards.</p> <p>Tricky word games: <b>Go Fish</b> - place all the flashcards down on the table and if you can read the word, you can keep the card.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Comparing &amp; Ordering 1-5 -pg 92 in <b>Cracking Maths Workbook</b> Complete lots of counting games to help order &amp; sequence numbers 1-10 -forwards/backwards Display numbers 1-5 on pieces of card - remove 1 numeral and guess the missing number, order number cards 1-5.</p> <p><b>Gaeilge:</b> Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) ceacht 1 (lesson 1) - listen to words on See-saw and sing song each day along with the video</p> <p><b>Physical Education (P.E):</b> Choose an activity from the Super Trooper Journal in your child's homework folder. <b>Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> April</b>	<p><b>English: Writing</b> -Look at <i>Mrs Murphy's handwriting copy 2</i> (green cover) and find the next two pages. Trace your finger around the letter multiple times using your 'peter-pointer' and make the letter in the air/on the table/in a sand-tray etc. Now you are ready to begin writing! Make sure your child is sitting upright and holding her pencil with the correct pencil grip. Trace the letter and the bottom row is provided for independent practice (you might need to draw the dots for your child), make sure they keep the letter on the blue lines.</p> <p><i>Mrs Murphy's pattern copy 1 &amp; 3</i> (red/yellow covers) can be used as extra practice but is not necessary and your child can do as many or as little pages as she wishes.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Comparing &amp; Ordering 1-5 -pg 93 in <b>Cracking Maths Workbook</b> Revise writing numerals 1-5 -write the missing numeral</p> <p><b>Gaeilge:</b> Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) ceacht 1 (lesson 1) - listen to words on See-saw and sing song each day along with the video</p> <p><b>History:</b> Listen to the story -<i>Little Red Riding Hood</i> and retell the story to an adult describing what happened at the beginning and at the end of the story - draw your favourite part.</p>	<p><a href="https://www.nessy.com/uk/apps/hairy-letters">https://www.nessy.com/uk/apps/hairy-letters</a> - helps with letter formation</p> <p>Listen to the story on See-saw or alternatively copy and paste this link here: <a href="http://www.viewpure.com/OW86K1jBJFI?start=0&amp;end=0">http://www.viewpure.com/OW86K1jBJFI?start=0&amp;end=0</a></p>
<b>Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May</b>	<p><b>English: Word Lists</b> - continue to encourage your child to blend the words using 'stretchy snake' on the word lists provided in your child's homework folder.</p> <p>Dictation - call out a letter sound and ask your child to write it down e.g. use mini-white/blackboards, blank page copies or sheets, as your child becomes familiar with the individual letters you can call out words from their word-lists and encourage your child to write them down from ear.</p>	

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**Maths:** *Cracking Maths Home Link Workbook* can be used as extra material pgs 31-32 but not necessary.

**Gaeilge:** Theme: Éadaí (Clothes) ceacht 1 (lesson 1) - listen to words on See-saw and sing song each day along with the video

**Grow in Love:** Look at pages 62 & 63 in **Grow in Love workbook**. Some activities in the workbook require you to read the stories online which are available to parents during this time.
